Classroom Expectations

Course Materials

Late Work

Late work will receive a 0 for Habits of Mind and will not have the opportunity for revision. You will have 7 days from when the assignment is passed back for any revisions for evidence in your mastery column. After 7 days, late work will not be accepted at all. In order to be eligible for revisions you must have first turned in some evidence. If you do not turn in any work, you will not be eligible for revisions.

Technological Devices

Cell phones, iPods, and other similar technological devices will not be permitted during class time. There may be times during class when it will be appropriate to have such devices out, which I will specify. Otherwise, it will be confiscated, and your parent will need to pick it up from me at a later time.

Food & Drink

Drinks are allowed during class time as long as they are manageable and easy to maintain without disturbing others. All other food or drinks belong outside of the classroom.

Backpacks/Bags
